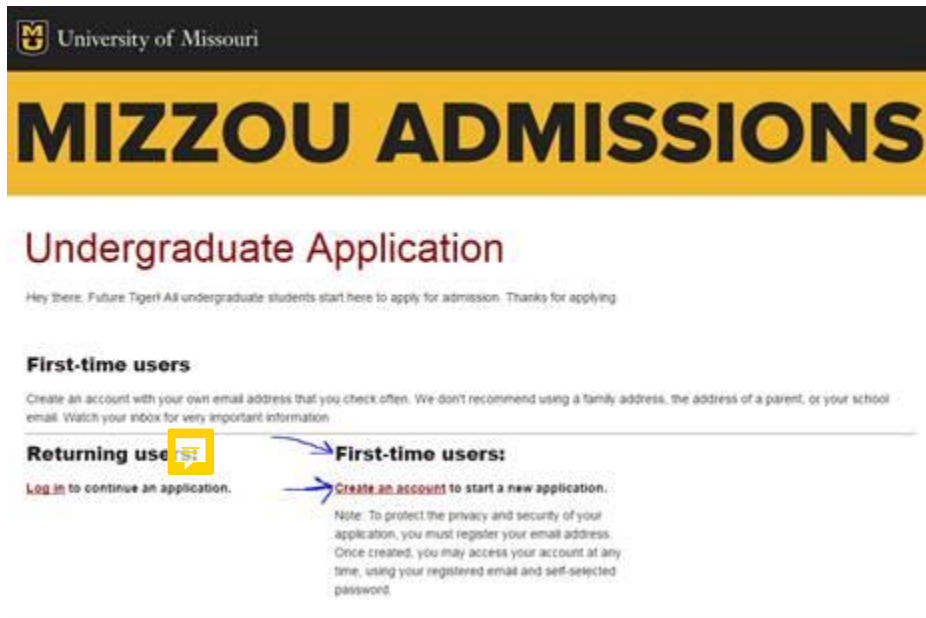
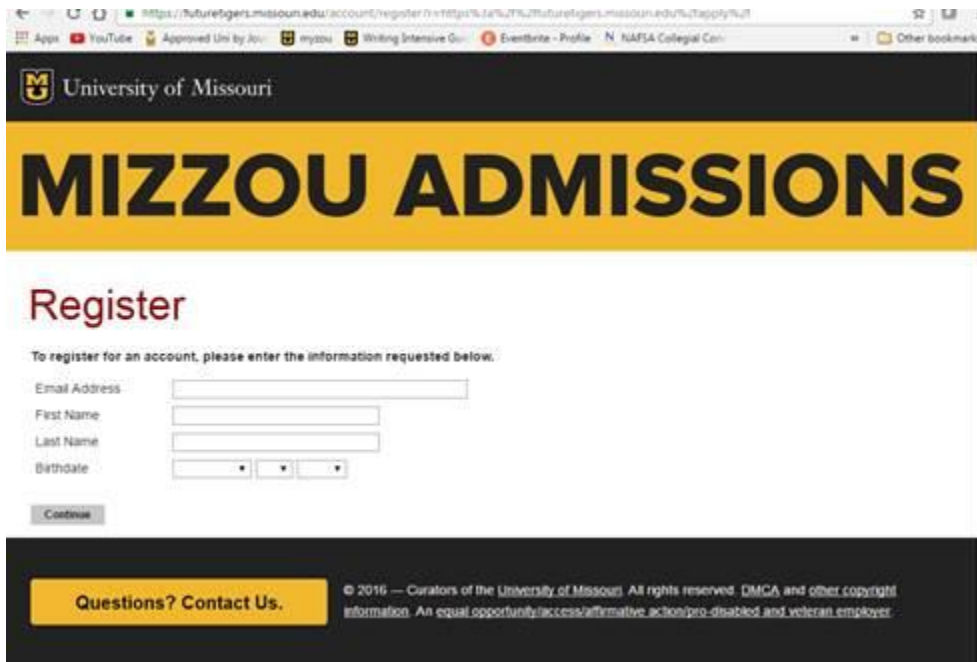


How to Apply as 3+2 student



14. On test scores: if the student did not have test scores (IELTS, TOEFL) score then they can skip this item.
15. On Family Page: Add parents information
16. Additional Information: the student should respond with an appropriate answer
17. Signature: student enter their name

18. Once all the required Items are finalized the student can submit their application, as you can see this application is missing the test scores, which is fine. The student can send the scores via ETS once they have the test taken.

19. After you approve applicants, you can advise them to apply online, once you made sure that all have applied you can send the IOF via email to our office: either my email or Urska. We will be able to push the application and process the payment through your department.

So I think it is best that you receive their documents. Decide if you will accept them or not through your selection process. Then ask them to apply online. We prefer to receive a list of the students who will be on the 3+2 program so we can mark them in the system. They should provide you will an Undergraduate Application Number: which is on the top left side of the screen on the Application Review Page.

- **Copies of Official transcripts from all Colleges or Universities attended.** Can be accepted as a PDF for initial screening
- **TOEFL or IELTS score;** submit using our college code 6875. Via ETS.
- **Financial documents; bank statement and Affidavit of Support** Can be accepted as a PDF; we don't need originals
- **Copy of your passport.** Can be accepted as a PDF.
MU will accept scanned copies of transcripts for initial evaluation. Copies of financials, affidavit of support and Passport in PDF format. Please make sure to submit them as PDF attachments. We will not open links, zip files, RAR files, or Google shared files. Test scores are submitted through testing agencies.
